From Sharon's Desk

As a board member of the Missouri Coalition Against Domestic and Sexual Violence (MCADSV), I lobby state legislators. I have lobbied both our state and national legislators. One of the most successful efforts we have had in Missouri this year was the House of Representatives on Thursday night, 5/5/11, unanimously passed Senate Bill 320, sending this far-reaching domestic violence bill to the Governor to be signed into law. On the same day, both the House and the Missouri Senate passed the Fiscal Year 2012 state budget with a total of more than \$2.36 million in funding increases for domestic violence services and sexual assault forensic examinations. In yet another year of fiscal constraints for the state, it was a tremendous victory to gain bi-partisan support for these MCADSV priority funding increases. It also is to our credit that lawmakers put aside so many differences to be united in efforts to pass legislation to address violence against women. (MCADSV, 2011). Further, to keep up to date on what is happening in the capitol we receive e-mail alerts before important issues related to domestic violence are brought to a vote. These e-mails are forwarded, with instructions concerning contacting state or national legislators. We express our views and explain the impact of the vote on the people we serve. Our law makers really do listen to their constituents! Why bring this up? I have spent many, many hours this spring meeting with legislators in the capitol and attending hearing concerning bills concerning domestic and sexual violence
